

Authors' Guidelines

General Information

SAJPC (South Asian Journal of Preventative Cardiology) is a peer-reviewed, journal publishing in English original research studies, reviews and case reports in preventative cardiology. Symposia or workshop papers may be published as supplements.

The submitted manuscript should not have been previously published in any form and must not be currently under consideration for publication elsewhere.

Authors are invited to provide the names of three well qualified reviewers. Current e-mail addresses must be provided for all suggested reviewers.

An author declaration form should be signed by all authors. A template for this form is included at website

A copyright transfer agreement should be signed prior the acceptance for publication.

Review Process

Manuscripts not adhering to journal guidelines will be returned to authors without scientific evaluation. Submitted manuscripts adhering to journal guidelines are reviewed by the Editor-in-Chief or an Hon. Editor, who will assign them to reviewers. The Editorial Board prepares a decision letter according to the comments of the reviewers, which is sent to the corresponding author.

All non reviewed manuscripts will be sent back within 6 weeks and decisions letters of manuscripts will be sent within 12 weeks.

Manuscript Preparation

To expedite the review process, please format the manuscript in ways as follow:

1. Prepare your manuscript as editable Word document. It should include the Abstract, Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion, Acknowledgements Disclosure and References, Tables and Figures.
2. Manuscripts should be written in English and include a 100-300 word abstract.
3. Make sure all the characters in the text, tables, figure legends, footnotes and references are in a single typeface and point size - such as 12 pt Times New Roman. Once a manuscript is accepted, a copy editor will decide the typeface and

size of the different elements of the article.

4. Submit all figures or photographs as jpg files with distinct characters and symbols at 500 dpi (dots per inch). Tables must be edited with Word. Equations must be edited with Equation Editor.
5. Type your manuscript single spaced. This will save pages, makes it easier for reviewers to handle.
6. All references should be numbered in square brackets in the text and listed in the REFERENCES section in the order they appear in the text, as shown below:
